Safety & Handling Information for ACQ Treated Wood

- Do not burn pressure-treated wood.
- Wear a dust mask and goggles when cutting or handling treated (and untreated) wood.
- Wear gloves when working with treated (and untreated) wood.
- After working with treated wood exposed areas thoroughly.
- Wash work clothes separately from other household clothing before reuse.
- Treated wood should not be used where it may come into direct or indirect contact with drinking water, except for uses involving incidental contact such as fresh water docks and bridges.
- Do not use treated wood under circumstances where the preservative may become a component of food, animal feed, or beehives.
- Do not use treated wood for mulch.
- Treated wood scraps, cutoffs, broken boards, sawdust or treated wood material taken out of service are not considered hazardous and may be disposed of in landfills in accordance with local, state and federal regulations.
- Do not burn pressure-treated wood on site. It may only be burned in commercial or industrial incinerators or boilers in accordance with state and federal regulations.
